

Code of Conduct for StrathglassShinty Club

The aim of this code is to provide clarity on what is expected of being a member of StrathglassShinty Club and it is hoped will aid the smooth running of the Club in the future.

- All players are expected to be respectful to fellow players, management and officials at all times. To act as an ambassador for the club and community and not act in any way that brings the club into disrepute.
- We expect senior players to contribute to fundraising and community events, supporting youth teams and general club development.
- All players must pay a subscription (as determined by the management committee) in order to be eligible for selection. This must be paid, at least in part, before the first league game of the season.
- All players must pay a contribution (as determined by the management committee) towards costs when travelling to away matches on hired transport.
- Players are expected to attend training sessions. If they cannot attend the manager/ coach should be informed at the earliest convenience.
- Players when aware of their unavailability for a given match should notify the manager/coach at the earliest possible opportunity.
- Players are expected to arrive at matches at least one hour prior to throw up.
- Players are expected to attend all matches physically and mentally prepared. Any player found to be unfit through irresponsible behaviour can expect to be dealt with by the management.
- Players should notify the team management at the earliest possible opportunity of any prearranged function prior to games.

The Club are looking for the first team pool to be players to be committed to both regular training and making themselves available for selection every Saturday.

We hope that the players themselves will encourage one another to comply with these guidelines.
